This is not Europe or America. It's newly built Atal Pedestrial Bridge' in Ahmedabad on the banks of river Sabarmati, by Ahmedabad Municipal corporation on the cost of 74 crore rupees. It was inaugurated by prime minister Narendra Modi on August 27. This bridge design is inspired by kite festival organised in the city. It is about 300 meters long and 14 meters wide. It is built by using 2600 metric tonnes of steel.

Atal Bridge is now open for the visitors and it will remain open from 9 am to 9 pm for pedestrians. The entry fee for this bridge is 30 rupees for 30 minutes children below 12 and senior citizen above 60 have to pay 15 rupees. However, it is free for the person with disabilities.
